



# MSED in Educational Leadership

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## Program Overview

This 30-credit hour degree is designed for elementary and secondary teachers for the MSED. It is also designed for school leaders seeking positions as school principals or superintendents.

## Clinical Experiences Requirement

Clinical experience is completed in students' local P-12 schools and may be completed in the student's place of employment.

Students must complete two complete clinical experiences (Practicum or Internship) is to be completed at the elementary level (PK-6

## Admission Requirements

Admission to this degree program is based on:

1. Teaching or Counseling certification
2. K-12 school experience (three years)
3. Official transcripts of all prior college work
4. 3.00 or better GPA
5. Interview
6. Writing sample
7. Principles of supervision (at least one from a

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experience at the elementary level (PK-6<sup>th</sup> grade) and the other experience at the secondary level (7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade).

Students who are teaching in K-12 school settings may be eligible to complete their clinical experiences in their own schools.

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
