

Students accepted into this competitive program have a provisional seat waiting for them at the LECOM School of Pharmacy after attending St. Bonaventure University for three or four years. The program is completed with an additional three or four years at LECOM, with all of the options leading to both a B.S. and a PharmD. degree.

Accepted students receive a provisional letter of acceptance to LECOM upon entering the program at SBU, and a seat is reserved at the LECOM School of Pharmacy. Academic, comportment, and procedural requirements must be maintained while at St. Bonaventure in order to move on to the School of Pharmacy. Requirements are detailed in writing when a place is offered in the program.

In Phase I of the program, students spend three or four years at St. Bonaventure. For the three-year option at SBU a biology major is required. With the four-year option, other majors are possible provided pharmacy school prerequisites are fulfilled. The
