- financial institutions and markets

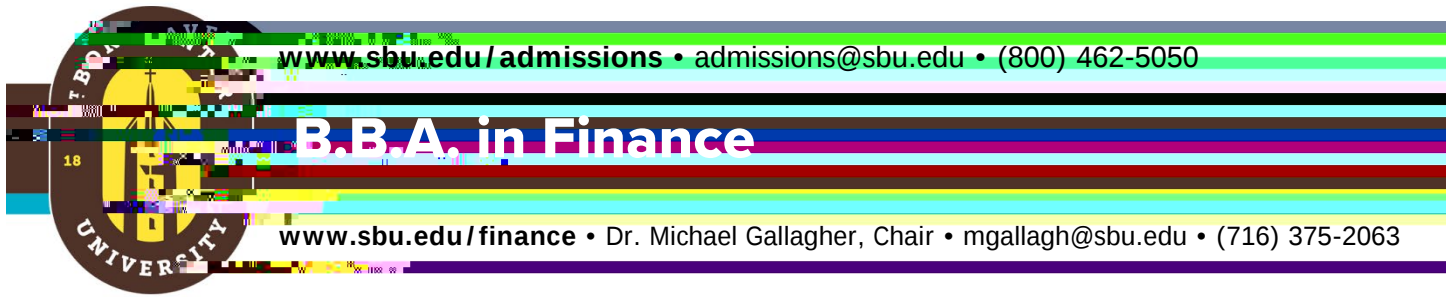
Finance students are required to complete a minimum of 6 elective credits and may choose from
